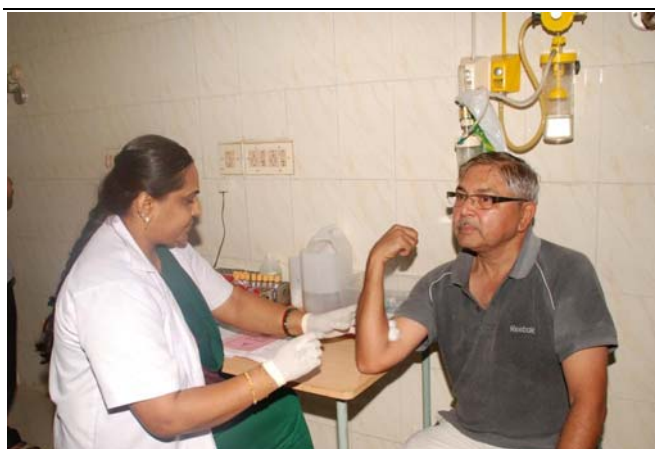

Master health check up for officers was launched on 22<sup>nd</sup> April.

In 2011-12, ICF has rolled out 1,511 coaches, a record, against a target of 1,503 coaches. Target of 2012-2013 is 1,525 coaches. The production in 2011-12 comprised 405 EMUs, 716 SL coaches, 162 AC coaches, 141 DEMUs, 48 AC coaches for Kolkata Metro, 39 SS DEMU coaches for export. AC/DC EMUs for the Mumbai suburban system and a first ever mobile Emission Test Car to test emission levels of diesel locomotives were also produced. ICF is gearing up to make stainless steel shells, high-speed bogies as part of its expansion plans. Work on producing (Linke Holfmann Bush) LHB type of coaches will start soon. The railways announced in the budget that LHB design coaches would be used in the future. With ERP, the shop floor goings-on will be revealed to the management in a meaningful manner. It can also be used to identify cost effective solution for different technologies.

✓ 44 Bio-toilets in 23 coaches of the Guwahati-MS Exp have been fitted in Oct’11. The performance of these toilets was being monitored jointly by the DRDE and ICF. The feedback is positive. Hence ICF is going to roll out coaches with 1200 Bio-toilets in 2012-13.

✓ Tr#22606 Villupuram (Dep Sat 10.40) –Purulia (Arr Sun 23.10) Weekly Super fast Express via vellore, renigunta has been introduced from 21st April. Tr#22605 Purulia (Dep Mon 10.35) – Villupuram (Arr Tue 23.00) introduced from 23rd April.

✓ Southern Railway is the first Zonal Railway to introduce e-auction for the sale of scrap. The e-auction system of Southern Railway Stores Department, for selling of scrap materials was formally launched on 11th April by Shri Deepak Krishan, GM/SR. Scrap purchasers all over the country can offer their bids on-line in a fair and transparent manner. To participate in e-auction, purchasers will have to register themselves and should have internet banking account with SBI. On commencement of e-auction, scrap material worth ₹22 lakhs have been sold. SR is selling scrap materials to the tune of ₹350 crores per annum.

Sri. B.Akash, (of Class XII) S/O, C.Balamurugan, SSE/ICF (Deputation in RITES) has been selected provisionally for the KVPY fellowship award-2011, based on the aptitude test and the interview conducted by IISC, Bangalore.

He is eligible to get Rs. 5000 to 7000 per month, on joining undergraduate programme in Basic Sciences in the next academic year. KVPY (Kishore Vaigyanic Protsahan Yojana) exam is being conducted by Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and the selected students are awarded National Fellowships in research careers.

✓ The Diesel Multiple Unit (DMU) factory at Haldia is likely to be commissioned by the end of November this year. In the first phase it will produce one rake consisting of 8 coaches every month. On completion of second phase, 50 rakes will be produced annually.

✓ For the benefit of the Sikh pilgrims across the country, a luxury train covering all the leading Sikh shrines in the country (Amritsar, Talwandi, Anandpur, Patna and Nanded) will be flagged off in December.

✓ With an aim of hauling heavier trains, Railways is ready to roll out a newly-designed 5500 horse power (HP) diesel locomotive equipped with all modern features including speed of 100 kmph. Aptly named as "Bheem", the HHP loco is currently undergoing safety trial. Manufactured at DLW, the prototype has cost about Rs 17 crore. DLW will manufacture 15 such locomotives in the current fiscal. Designed jointly by the Railways and EMD, a US-based company, the loco has a provision of toilet for crew, a first in railways. It is fuel efficient as it is equipped with electronic fuel injection and emission control system. The loco comes with a huge fuel capacity of 7500 litres to provide long runs without re-fuelling.

✓ Pakistan has submitted a new proposal to buy or take on lease about 100 rail engines from India for re-starting its defunct train services. Of its fleet of 520 locomotives of the Pakistan Railways (PR), only 76 were operational in the month of March 2012. Acute shortage of locomotives has forced the Pakistan Railways to suspend operations of as many as 128 passenger trains. IR has 4,214 electric and 6,000 diesel engines.

✓ **Saved through email:** On 1st April, Ali Khan was travelling along with his sister Ziana Liakath by the Kerala Express to New Delhi. He got down at Vijayawada to drink water, but did not return. The girl saw the sticker with mail ID of the GRP (grprly@gmail.com) pasted on the coach. From her laptop she gave information to the GRP through email. Responding to the e-mail, Mr. Kantha Rao, SP/GRP/BZA alerted his team. GRP/Khammam noticed an unconscious boy near the railway track, identified as Ali Khan on confirmation with GRP/BZA and admitted the boy to Khammam GH. They informed the girl also. On enquiry it was found that the victim, who boarded the running train in BZA, fell from the train after it crossed Khammam railway station, while he was trying to move from one compartment to the other.

✓ As part of the Celebration of 140 years of existence of Chennai Central station, GM/SR inaugurated a Mural (Painting Exhibition) at the station on 24<sup>th</sup> April. It was Commissioned for passenger traffic with only 4 short platforms on April 7, 1873 to decongest south India's third oldest Railway Station, Royapuram

✓ A 600 MW solar power park, Asia's first and the largest, was dedicated to the nation by the CM of Gujarat, Sri Narendra Modi on 19th April. Covering approximately 3,000 acres of wasteland bordering the Rann of Kutch, it will generate two-thirds of India's total 900 MW of solar power production. By installing solar panels over water reservoirs it also reduces the evaporation of water.
