- (a) Railway persons working as employees of Indian Railways, Konkan Railway, Port Trust Railways, RITES, IRCON, CONCOR, CRIS, DMRC, RLDA and other organizations and Public Sectors undertakings under Ministry of Railways are included in this category) High School/SSC or equivalent qualification with maths or science and having a minimum of 3 years experience in Railways or 3-year Diploma in any Engineering Discipline recognised by Central/State or Union Territory Government or a Science/Engineering Graduate or a Graduate with Science/ Maths as one of the subjects in Intermediate/Plus 2 of SSC.
- (b) Non-Railway persons: The applicants should be a 3-year Diploma holder in any discipline of Engineering recognised by Central/State or UT Government or a Science/Engineering Graduate or a Graduate with Maths/Science as one of the subjects in Intermediate/Plus 2 of S.S.C.
