COMMERCIAL CIRCULAR NO. 16 OF 2010

Sub: Grant of 100% concession to Cancer patients in 3AC and Sleeper Class.

As per extant rules, cancer patients and their escorts are eligible for concession in railway fares for going to (and returning from) recognized Hospitals for treatment and periodic checkup. The element of concession is 75% in 2nd/Sleeper/1st/3-AC/AC Chair-Car and 50% in 2AC/1AC.

2. As announced by Hon'ble MR in Budget Speech for 2010-11, it has been decided to enhance the element of concession to cancer patients in 3-AC and Sleeper class from existing 75% to 100%.

3. The element of concession for escort in 3-AC and Sleeper remains unchanged i.e. 75%.

4. The 100% concession to the cancer patient is admissible only in the basic fares of Mail/Express trains and all other charges will be realized in full. The concession will be admissible subject to the conditions mentioned in S.No.11(1) & (2) of Annexure to rule 101 of IRCA Coaching Tariff No. 25, Part-I (Vol. II).

5. The element of concession for cancer patients and their escorts in other classes i.e. 2nd/1st class/AC Chair-Car and 2AC/1AC shall remain unchanged at 75% and 50% respectively.

6. This concession will be admissible on tickets purchased on and after 20.4.2010.


7. In cases of tickets already issued for travel on & after 20.4.2010, refund of difference of fares will not be admissible.

8. There are no changes in other terms and conditions. Wide publicity through various media may be given at regular intervals.




