**Sub: Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme(MACPS)**

In continuation of this office letters of even number dated 11<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2009, we would like to bring to your kind that the DoP&T in the orders circulated by vide their O.M.No.35034/3/2008-Estt.(D) dated 19-5-2009 have omitted reckoning of 50% of temporary status casual labour service on absorption in regular employment for granting ACP.

This matter was discussed in the Departmental Council(JCM) Meeting and orders were issued by the Railway Board vide their letter No.PC-V/2004/ACP/1 dt.31-3-2004(RBE No.69/2004) that 50% of temporary status casual labour service on absorption in regular employment may be taken into account towards minimum service of 12/24 years for grant of benefit under ACP Scheme on the analogy that the same is also reckoned as qualifying service for pension.

In view of the above, you are requested to raise this issue with the DOP&T for modifying their letter by inclusion of reckoning 50% of temporary status casual labour service on absorption in regular employment for granting ACP after 10/20/30 years of service.
