MAJOR CHANGES PROPOSED IN PROCEDURE FOR PROMOTIONS FROM GROUP 'C' TO GROUP 'B'

Following major changes are under consideration of the Railway Board, to be made in the procedure for promotion from Group C to Group B – (as per information received under the RTI Act by GS IRTSA):

- 1. a) Upgradation of 3335 apex Group 'C' posts to Group 'B' Gazetted on functional basis.
 - b) 1243 posts will get upgraded if 15% of 8285 Group B posts are upgraded from Group C to Group B,.
- 2. Group 'B' posts proposed to be filed up by 30% Promotional quota and 70% LDCE (instead of 70% Promotional quota and 30% LDCE at present).
 - (Board is being pursued to increase the Promotional quota to at least 50%)>
- 3. a) Posts against LDCE quota will be filled up through examination with atleast 50% objective type questions.
 - b) Promotion through seniority-cum-suitability for Promotional quota for Group B posts.
- 4. Centralised examination for LDCE quota for Group B on all India basis to check alleged corruption in Group B selections.
