**Sub: 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Report - Pay level recommended for Chemical & Metallurgical Engineers.**

Ref : 1. Para No 11.40.124 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC report on Chemical & Metallurgical Employees.

2. Railway Board letter No.E (NG)-II/2004/RR-1/5Pt (RBE No.24/2018) Dated 16.02.2018

1. Chemical & Metallurgical Organization is engaged in testing and certifying of all raw materials and vital safety items like Wheels, Axles, Springs, Bogie frames and controlling production-processes in the manufacture of Rolling stocks/Coaches, thereby assuring usage of standard materials and ensuring safety of travelling public. The Railway Board Management Services has considered C&M Organisation as the backbone of entire Quality Control and preventive maintenance exercise of all Engineering departments.
2. Cadre strength of Chemical & Metallurgy is given below,

3. **Vide para 11.40.124, 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommended that, Chemical and Metallurgical Assistants should be upgraded to GP Rs.4600, Chemical and Metallurgical Superintendents to GP Rs.4800, and Assistant Chemist and Metallurgist to GP Rs.5400 (PB-2).**
4. Above recommendation of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC has been kept pending by Railway Board.
5. Railway Board through its letter No. E (NG)-II/2004/RR-1/5Pt (RBE No.24/2018) dated 16.02.2018 prescribed Pay Level-6 for CMA and Pay Level-7 for CMS, which is against 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations.
6. **It is requested not to dilute the recommendations of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC on the pay level of CMA & CMS and they may be granted pay level-7 & pay level-8 respectively.**
