POINTS RAISED IN GMs CONFERENCE BY COM. S. G. MISHRA, GS AIRF ON 24-25 AUG, 2012

- i) a) Denial of Rs.4800 G.P as an apex grade for Supervisors working in Open Line, sheds and workshops;
 - b) Non-implementation of 15% upgradation of the for supervisors working in Open Line, sheds and workshops in the Apex grade post as Group-B as agreed;
- are agitating the minds of the middle level management staff and need to be redressed.
- ii) The Sr.PWS are not yet merged with JE's and the MACP for these cadre is also not implemented. Despite the fact that, all these exercise has no financial burden or implication.
- iii) Dilapidated condition of Railway Quarters and non-maintenance of this residential accommodation citing financial constraint are deplorable.
- iv) Deteriorating conditions and non-maintenance of Subordinate Rest Houses are seriously affecting the efficiency of railway men and demanded adequate allocation of funds for maintenance.
- v) While he demanded immediate stoppage of surrender of post, he emphasized the need for additional creation of new posts to maintain the ever increasing new assets like, introduction of new trains, diversion and extension of service, additional new lines etc.
- vi) demanded facilities to parents and privilege passes and also eligibility to travel on Duronto Express on privilege pass as in the case of Rajdhani / Shatabdi Express.
- vii) He also pointed out that, various welfare schemes announced by the then Hon'ble MR like opening of schools, polytechnics, Engineering College / Medical College, nursing schools, mobile medical van for all divisions, medical facilities to parents and house for all railway men are not taken up for implementation,

Hon'ble MR has assured that, all the assurances made by the then MR either in parliament or outside will be implemented in full spirit and demands like implementation of Cadre Restructuring Committee, will be resolved on priority.
